

Communiqué

Meeting of the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia held on 28 October 2016 at the AHPRA National Office, Melbourne.

The Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (the National Board or NMBA) is the national regulator for nursing and midwifery in Australia. It is established under the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law, as in force in each state and territory (<u>the National Law</u>).

The NMBA meets monthly and considers a range of matters, the most important of which are published in this Communiqué.

NMBA regulatory planning day

The NMBA held its regulatory planning day to determine the key elements of its regulatory plan for 2017-2020 and position the NMBA for 2020. Topics in focus included how to better engage and educate nurses and midwives regarding regulatory responsibilities, and how to better position NMBA as a risk-based and adaptive regulator.

NMBA brand identity workshop

In addition to the regulatory planning day, the NMBA completed a brand identity workshop with a focus on further engagement with nurses and midwives, to continue to support safe care for the public.

NMBA Committee Chairs attend State and Territory Chairs meeting

The NMBA Committee Chairs attended the 13 October meeting of the NMBA State and Territory Chairs. Their attendance provided opportunities for engagement with the work of the state and territory boards and to share information about the work of the NMBA.
